

Baldwin County Child Advocacy Center (Care House)

The **mission** of the Baldwin County Child Advocacy Center (BCCAC) is to provide resources and services to child victims of sexual abuse and severe physical abuse, their supportive family members, and the community through a multidisciplinary team approach while empowering all toward child abuse prevention.

Baldwin County Sheriff's Boys Ranch

In 1984, the Baldwin County Sheriff's Boys Ranch was established in Summerdale, AL, on land that was donated by John B. Foley, to provide young men with a home environment with house parents to live and train up in the way of the Lord. The campus includes two ranch homes, a chapel, gym, pool, office, two staff houses, the boys college home and support buildings. The boys attend Foley First Baptist Church on Sundays and Wednesdays. Ranchers attend Elberta, Foley and Summerdale schools where they participate in activities such as sports, academic clubs, band and ROTC. Highlights for the year include fishing and beach trips, concerts, campouts, church youth activities including mission trips and cookouts.

Betty & Floyd Repogle Undergraduate Scholarship for LMC High School Graduates

This scholarship is for undergraduate Lillian MC members 17-25 years of age. The scholarship was started by the church and named in memory of Betty Repogle. In 2020 upon the death of Floyd, the church extended the name to the Betty & Floyd Repogle Undergraduate Scholarship.

Bright Bridge Ministries

Bright Bridge is our local Pensacola District mission to the Brownsville community providing dignity and welfare of the under resourced in our community by addressing their physical, emotional and spiritual needs. There, hot and healthy meal service is often a way to introduce those in need to all the services they offer. Most of their meal clients walk or ride their bike to the location. They also provide mail service, basic needs, addiction resources, job placement and other empowering services. In the past three years, Bright Bridge Ministries has served over 1000,000 hot meals and distributed 3,450 hygiene kits. At least 120 individuals have earned a bike through volunteering at least 30 hours at Bright Bridge.

Discretionary Fund

This fund is used to help a family that is experiencing a debilitating loss (such as an auto accident, fire, health issues, overdue utilities, etc.) get back on their feet.

Embrace AL/FL Kids (Methodist Children's Home)

Embrace AL/FL Kids is located in Santa Rosa County, FL and is a faith-based agency focused on providing homes, healing and hope to vulnerable children who come from families in crisis and are placed in foster care thru no fault of their own.

Family Promise of Baldwin County

Family Promise provides temporary shelter, transitional housing, related services and nurturing support to families with children experiencing homelessness and to assist them with obtaining suitable and permanent housing. Churches host these families overnight and this ensures that families in crises can stay together as they work toward housing.

Gulf Coast Kid's House

The Gulf Coast Kid's House is a children's advocacy center serving Pensacola and Escambia County. As a children's advocacy center, they combine all of the professionals and resources needed for the intervention, investigation and prosecution of child abuse cases under one child-friendly facility. Child victims and their families also receive mental health counseling at the center. The goal of the Gulf Coast Kid's House is to form a more collaborative response to child abuse cases so that they can improve case outcomes and minimize trauma to the children and families they serve.

Kairos Outside South AL

A Christian, lay-led, ecumenical, volunteer, international ministry in which men and women bring Christ's love and forgiveness to incarcerated individuals and their families. Many come to Christ through this program.

Lillian Methodist Men's Car Show

We show our support by sponsoring one of the awards at the annual car show.

Lillian Methodist Church Shut-Ins

Max-Well Respite (Christmas Gifts for Children)

Max-Well Respite Center is a 17,000 square foot transitional housing program designed to help families, couples, and single parents by bringing skills to their minds, body, and soul. The Life Skills program is to support others in their development of skills that will enhance personal growth, gives others' skills that will support them in growing their ability to be as independent and successful as possible. Our mission is to help physically, spiritually, mentally, and socially those in need in a way that will be rooted in the whole person as they return as a productive member of the community. Covering their needs and growing their strengths in all aspects of self improvement.

Red Bird Methodist Mission

Red Bird Mission is a non-profit agency located in the Appalachian mountains of Southeastern Kentucky that empowers individuals and advocates justice by providing educational, health and community outreach ministries to area low-income residents. They provide a K-12 Christian school, residential dormitories, early childhood development, as well as, The Red Bird Clinic, Inc., community aid ministries, elderly ministries, family ministries, women and children ministries, a community store, craft store & marketing, work camp, home repair and mission facilities.

Shepherd of the Bay Lutheran Food Pantry

Shepherd of the Bay distributes food locally twice a month to those in need.

Stegall Foundation Seminary Scholarship

These funds help to support certified candidates for ministry from the Global Methodist Church Annual Conference who attend seminary and/or Course of Study.

Teen Challenge of Pensacola, FL

Teens voluntarily sign a two-year contract. They live in a facility confidentially located in Pensacola. Some of the recipients are through the court system and are addicted to drugs.
