**MISSION ITEMS NEEDED**

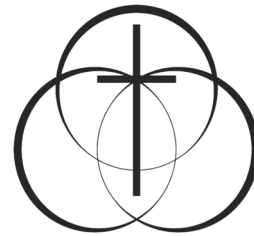

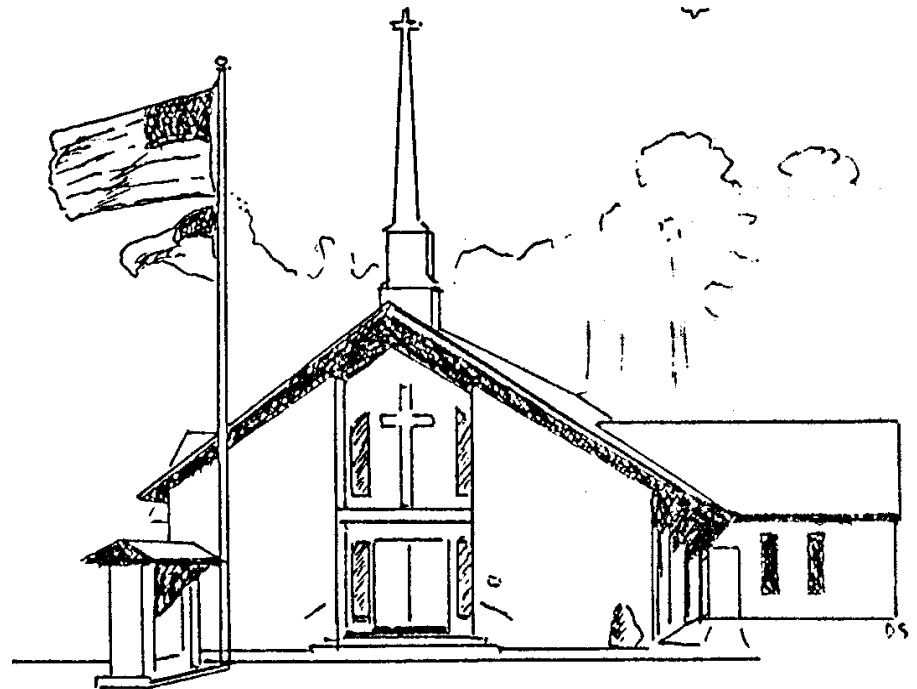
