MISSION ITEMS NEEDED

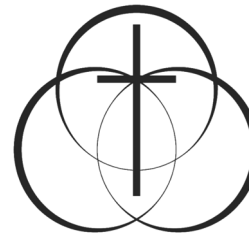

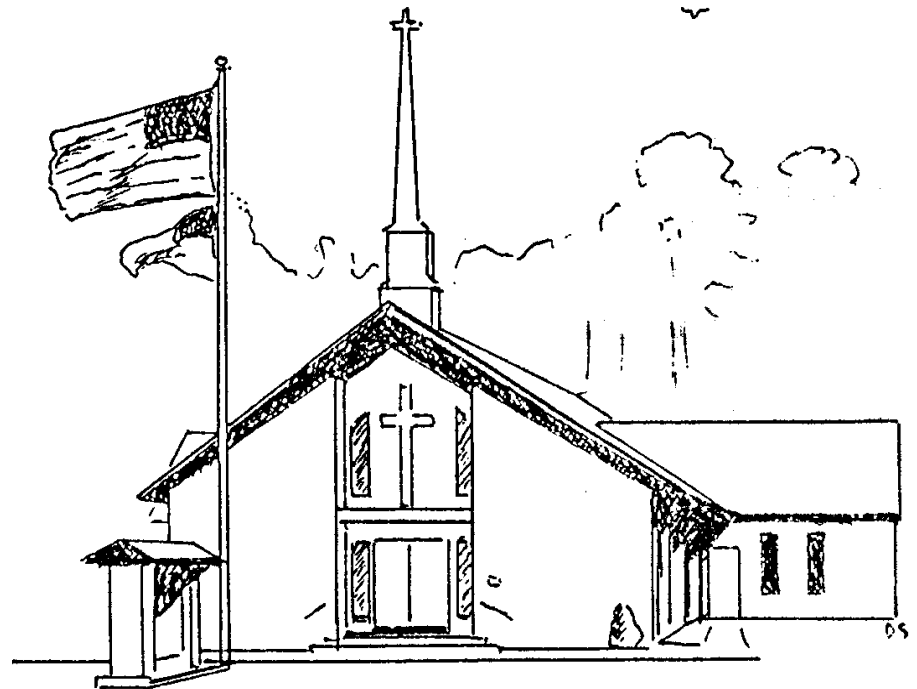
