Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Beat the butter and honey for one minute. Add eggs and vanilla and beat on medium for another minute.

In a separate bowl, mix flour, oats, baking soda, salt, & cinnamon.

Slowly add the dry ingredients to the wet ingredients.

Stir in raisins and drop by spoonfuls on a cookie sheet.

Bake for 12-14 minutes.
